

PRIVACY NOTICE

pursuant to Article 13 of the European Regulation 679/2016

This Privacy Notice describes the methods of personal data processing by **Giotto Technologies Srl** (hereinafter referred to as “Giotto Technologies” or “we”) as the data controller, in accordance with the provisions of EU Regulation 679/2016 (GDPR) and applicable national laws on the protection of personal data.

Personal Data Subject to Processing

Giotto Technologies processes various types of personal data, including:

- Identification data (e.g., name, surname, date of birth)
- Contact data (e.g., address, telephone number, email address)
- Professional data (e.g., company name, role, company address)
- Financial and payment data (e.g., banking information, transaction details)
- Data related to products and services provided or requested
- Communication data (e.g., call recordings, emails)
- Technical data (e.g., IP address, website browsing data)

Purposes of Processing

Giotto Technologies processes personal data for the following purposes:

- Execution of contracts and provision of products/services
- Administrative, accounting, and tax management
- Provision of assistance and technical support
- Management of requests and communications
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Marketing and commercial communications (with explicit consent)





Legal Basis for Processing

The processing of personal data by Giotto Technologies is based on one or more of the following legal bases:

- Execution of a contract or pre-contractual measures
- Compliance with a legal obligation
- Legitimate interests pursued by Giotto Technologies or third parties
- Consent of the data subject (only for marketing and commercial communications activities)

Data Communication and Transfer

Personal data may be communicated to third parties only if necessary for the aforementioned purposes, for example:

- Service providers and collaborators acting as data processors
- Public authorities, control bodies, or law enforcement agencies in compliance with legal obligations

Giotto Technologies does not transfer personal data to third countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

Data Retention Period

Personal data will be retained for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes of the processing, in compliance with applicable regulations. Once this period has elapsed, personal data will be deleted or irreversibly anonymized.

Data Security

Giotto Technologies implements adequate technical, organizational, and procedural security measures to protect personal data from unauthorized access, loss, alteration, or unlawful disclosure.

Data Subject's Rights

Data subjects have the right to:

- Access their personal data and obtain information about the processing
- Request the rectification or updating of their personal data
- Request the erasure of their personal data
- Restrict or object to the processing of their personal data
- Receive their personal data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format (right to data portability)
- Withdraw consent, where applicable, for processing activities requiring consent
- Lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority
